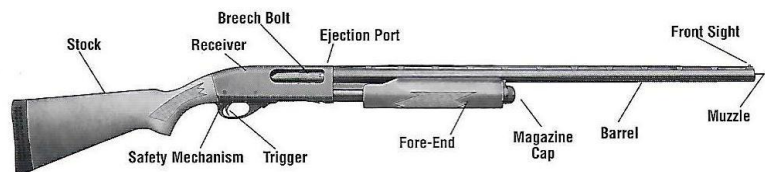

Annual Meeting and Elections at January Meeting; following is from ByLaws

Article V MEETINGS

Section 1. The Annual Meeting of the Club shall be held as set by the Board of Directors each year including the time and place, in conjunction with a monthly meeting.

The Annual Meeting shall be for the purpose of electing the required officers for the ensuing year and receiving written reports from the President, Secretary, Treasurer and Auditing Committee.

The Nominating Committee shall be appointed at the November monthly meeting.

Written notice of the Annual Meeting shall be given, mailed or e-mailed to each member a minimum of 14 days prior to the date of such meeting.

Article VI MANAGEMENT

Section 1. The management of the Club shall be vested in the Club Board of Directors which shall be the Club Officers: President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer and the most recent prior President, plus two (2) members in good standing.

Section 2. The Club Officers are elected at the Annual Meeting and shall serve for one (1) year or until their successors are elected. A maximum of 4 terms in 4 years, in one officer position, shall be limiting. The additional two Board Members shall be elected at the Annual Meeting.

Lake Watch for November 2017

Water: The weatherman said that we had 6 days with some snow and 4 days with some rain, but on only 2 days did snow accumulate, and that rapidly melted. The 4 days of rain didn't amount to much as the official precipitation for November was 0.05 inches. Temperatures ranged from 10 to 57 F.

Lake Ice: Low temps on Nov 5 – 6 caused thin ice over all of the lake, but this melted. A 2-day cold spell on the 21-22 again caused the lake to ice-over, except for some holes in the middle where geese rested each evening. There was a 10-day warm spell at the end of the month with daytime temps in the 40s and 50s that melted the ice sheet completely.

Recreation: The GFP pulled their dock on Nov 6 just as the lake was iced over. There was a crazy ice fisherman on a bucket off shore from the dam during this brief period of ice. Deer Season opened on Nov. 18.



Wildlife: Did anyone see any snow geese using the lake this fall? We had a good bunch of Canada geese using the lake all November. There were a few ducks but not many. A flock of about 2 dozen Common Mergansers (left) stopped by the north end of the lake for a Thanksgiving dinner of small fishes. In migration and winter, they mix with other fish-eating,



diving ducks such as Bufflehead, goldeneyes, and other species of mergansers. Yep. There was a couple of goldeneyes in with the "mergs" that visited this year. We will see the more common hooded merganser (right) in the spring as it competes with wood ducks for nesting places in the shoreline trees.

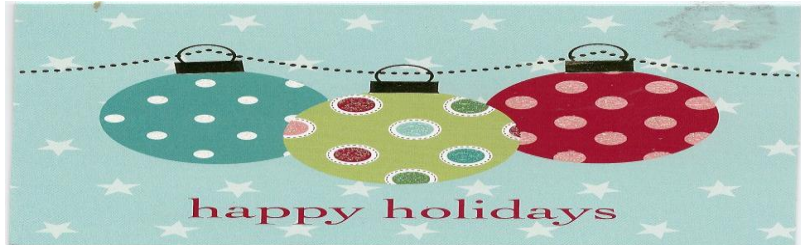
